



Activity	Day, Time & Age group	Activity Description
<p>Jolly Grammar</p> 	<p>Monday 3:30 – 4:30</p> <p>Ages 4 - 6</p>	<p>What is Jolly Grammar? Jolly Grammar uses an active and multi-sensory method of teaching with emphasis on consolidating the children's knowledge from Jolly Phonics and helping them develop an understanding of how grammar works. By teaching key essential grammar rules, it helps children bring diversity to their writing and improve their spelling in a structured way. Jolly Grammar teaches a wide range of language forms including the parts of speech, plurals, punctuation, and the tenses past, present, and future. Filled with great ideas and fun ways to remember some of the rules,</p> <p>Maximum 10 students per class</p> <p>Session Dates: 9/1, 16/1, 6/2, 13/2, 20/2, 27/2, 12/3, 19/3, 16/4, 23/4</p>
<p>Jolly Phonics</p> 	<p>Tuesday 3:30 – 4:30</p> <p>Ages 3 - 5</p>	<p>What is Jolly Phonics? Jolly Phonics is a fun and child centered approach to teaching literacy. With actions for each of the 42 letter sounds, the multi-sensory method is very motivating for children and teachers, who can see their students achieve. The sounds are taught in a specific order (not alphabetically), which enables children to begin building words as early as possible. Using a synthetic phonics approach, Jolly Phonics teaches children the five key skills for reading and writing.</p> <p>Maximum 10 Students per class</p> <p>Session Dates: 10/1, 17/1, 7/2, 14/2, 21/2, 28/2, 6/3, 13/3, 20/3, 10/4</p>

<p>Putonghua Speaking & Listening</p> 	<p>Tuesday 3:30 – 4:30</p> <p>Ages 3 - 5</p>	<p>Children will learn Putonghua in a fun, interactive and enjoyable environment through activities such as stories, song & rhymes, arts & crafts and games. Taught by our Putonghua teachers, the classes will focus on listening and speaking skills as well as increasing the children's confidence in using the language.</p> <p>Maximum 10 students per class</p> <p>Session Dates: 10/1, 17/1, 7/2, 14/2, 21/2, 28/2, 6/3, 13/3, 20/3, 10/4</p>
<p>Putonghua Reading & Writing</p> 	<p>Tuesday & Thursday 3:30 - 5:00</p> <p>Ages 4 - 6</p>	<p>The Putonghua reading and writing is designed for children who already have knowledge of spoken Chinese. This class introduces children to basic rules and structure of Chinese writing and calligraphy as well as increasing children's knowledge of Chinese characters by learning their shape, pronunciation and meaning. The classes are one and half-hour sessions, held twice a week.</p> <p>Maximum 8 students per class</p> <p>Session Dates: 5/1, 10/1, 17/1, 19/1, 2/2, 7/2, 14/2, 16/2, 21/2, 23/2, 28/2, 1/3, 6/3, 13/3, 15/3, 20/3, 22/3, 10/4, 12/4, 17/4</p>
<p>Putonghua Pin Yin</p> 	<p>Wednesday 3:30 - 4:30</p> <p>Ages 4 - 6</p>	<p>Pinyin helps to build a solid foundation for listening and speaking Putonghua. The aim of this program is to help children develop a foundation for proper Putonghua pronunciation as they learn initials & finals sounds and tone in Putonghua. Through this course, children will understand basic Putonghua syllables and learn simple Pin Yin.</p> <p>Maximum 8 students per class</p> <p>Session Dates: 11/1, 18/1, 8/2, 15/2, 22/2, 29/2, 7/3, 14/3, 21/3, 11/4</p>
<p>Interview Skills</p> 	<p>Wednesday 3:30 - 4:30</p> <p>Ages 3 – 5</p>	<p>This course is designed to help develop skills necessary for effective communication, presentation and social skills. It encourages children to speak with confidence in front of other people and prepare children for future primary school interviews.</p> <p>Maximum 10 students per class</p> <p>Session Dates: 11/1, 18/1, 8/2, 15/2, 22/2, 29/2, 7/3, 14/3, 21/3, 11/4</p>

Enrollment

- Complete the application form and return with a crossed cheque payable to "Super Brace Ltd."
- Enrollment will not be confirmed until minimum class numbers have been met.

Refund/Withdrawal

- No refund will be provided for students after the first class commences. Students who are successfully enrolled in a course and wished to withdraw before the course commences, will be charged 20% of the course fee.

Application Fee

- A non-refundable \$100 application fee is charged for students who are not PIPS students.

Absence/ Make-up classes/ Trial classes

- We regret that we cannot refund, credit or reschedule classes missed.
- To maintain a good class atmosphere, we do not offer trial classes as we believe it is normal for new student(s) to be a little uncomfortable at first (especially for young babies).

Enforced closures
