Welcome to the month of October! I am pleased to report that we have started the year very positively and our children have now settled very well at school. We are very pleased to see them all coming to school enthusiastically. Thank you to all our parents for your patience and cooperation during this first month, especially if it has been your child's first experience of school.

Each year level has now started their first unit of inquiry. It has been exciting to see the children so actively engaging in different activities in school.

The UKG and LKG are inquiring into the Unit 'Actions and Consequences'. There are lots of discussions about what we do and what might happen as a consequence. This has made the children think about which behaviours are good and which are not so good in this level.

The Nursery children are starting off learning about the 'Community'. They are going around the school to observe and interview people in our school community to find out what their roles are.

Our Pre-Nursery children are inquiring into the unit 'All About Me'. They have really enjoyed looking at their own and others' baby photos. They have realised that they are not babies anymore and now they are big children attending school by themselves. They seem very proud of this huge step!

Our playgroup children and parents are always having lots of fun in their classes exploring and playing in different learning areas. We can hear their singing and laughing coming from the classrooms!

#### **Dress Casual Day**


