Welcome back! We are delighted to resume school in person. Teachers and students are energised and ready to get back into the groove of learning and teaching. We are excited to start our final units of inquiry for this school year.

The **Pre-Nursery** level will further explore the wonderful world of the Arts. We will investigate and explore different art forms under the transdisciplinary theme of 'How We Express Ourselves'. Our focus would be on creating and responding to the various art forms, from singing, dancing, and drama to painting. The student will have the agency to choose and explore multiple art forms.

The **Nursery** will dive into the unit on 'Sharing the Planet'. This unit will look at natural resources and touch on conservation. Lots of science experiments and interesting students' questions will arise, which will lead to finding out more about our lovely planet. We hope that this unit will further develop our children's love of nature and to take care of the resources we use.

The **LK/UK/P** will explore the unit 'Where We Are in Place and Time'. Humanity has come a long way, and our children will analyse and compare past and present by looking at the development of cities. How have they changed, and why? Taking the lead from the interests of children, teachers plan meaningful learning engagements and help to promote their understanding of the unit.

Under 2's

For our Under 2's programme, we have a few more fun themes to explore before summer. The upcoming theme is all about yummy scrummy food. There is a plethora of food out there, and we will use our senses to learn more about food through the fun and hands-on activities. Our Under 2's teachers have planned some exciting learning engagements to explore food for our little ones.

With such a diverse number of units, we are all excited about our students' wonderings and questions regarding these units and the experiences gained from all the collaborative learning.

From the Under 2's to Kindergarten, our children will develop and enhance multiple lifelong skills throughout the units under the five primary skills, also known as the Approaches to Learning (ATLs):

- Thinking we make sense of our learning, and apply the lessons we've learned in our daily lives.
- **Self-management** we develop our confidence and our ability to manage ourselves, our feelings, and our responsibilities.
- **Communication** we find different ways to communicate and express our ideas, thoughts, and opinions.
- **Social** we develop our confidence in learning to play and learn together with our peers.
- **Research** we learn to find answers to our questions and solutions to our problems by making use of various sources.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

Vaccine Pass

Following the implementation of the "Vaccine Pass" enforced by the government, please be reminded that starting from 24th February 2022, except for those who are granted exemptions, all school staff and visitors must be vaccinated or otherwise will not be allowed to enter into the school premises. This applies to parents who enter the campus to pick-up and drop-off, as well as the accompanying adults in the Under 2's programme. A 'LeaveHomeSafe' QR code will be placed at the entrance of the school. Individuals over 12 years old are required to scan the QR code when they enter the school campus and show it to the staff member by the entrance or reception area.
