By the end of this unit, we hope that the children will be able to:

- Participate and contribute ideas collaboratively.

You can support your child at home by:

- Reading a variety of different literature including both fiction and nonfiction materials.
- Talking about the different elements of a story e.g. author, illustrator, settings and different characters in the story.
- Encouraging and praising when they use new words/phrases in their conversations at home.
- Actively seeking opinions and ideas about a story; including e.g. how they would like to change the story if they could and why.
