Learning Outcomes for 5th October to 27th November 2020

Language

- Use vocabulary focused on objects and people that are of importance
- Follow classroom directions and routines, using context cues.
- Identify people, places or ideas that visual images represent
- Join in with stories and poems, one-to-one and also in small groups

Mathematics

- Rote count 1-5
- Fit shapes into spaces on inset boards or jigsaw puzzles

Personal Social Physical Education (PSPE)

- Gradually negotiate the space and objects around them
- Use language to address their needs

Arts

- Respond to word, rhythm and/or music through movements
- Use voice to imitate sounds and learn songs
- Engage with a variety of visual arts experiences

Science

- Use senses to explore different materials
- Explore textures from the natural world

Identify different people within their immediate environment
