Last but not least, I thank you all for your continuous support in 2018 and wish you and your family a very happy holiday.

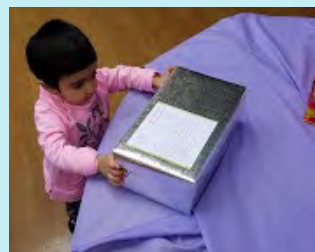

Annual Family Outing

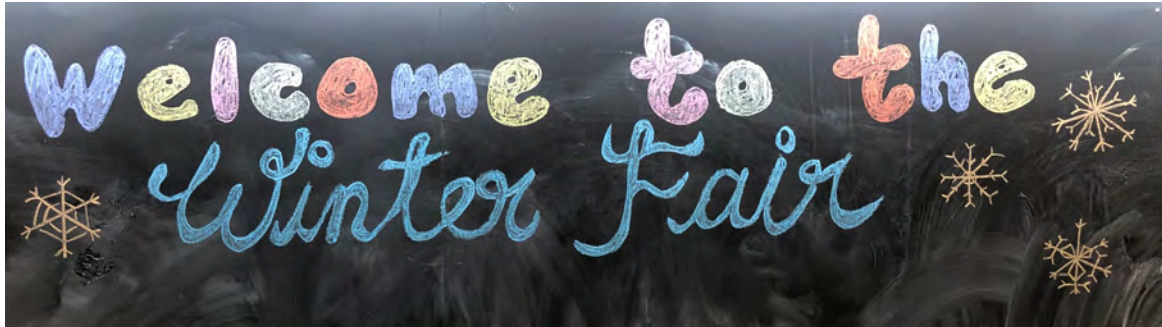
