Promoting the Learner Profile Attributes in PIPS

At PIPS, we believe in developing the whole child by providing quality education through inquiry and play-based learning. We aim to develop internationally minded children who are respectful, active and lifelong learners. As an IB PYP world school, the learner profile is an essential element that is evident throughout our learning and teaching:

Open-minded ~ We listen to other people's ideas. It's okay to be different.

Thinker ~ We use our ideas. We try to solve problems.

Inquirer ~ We are curious and enjoy learning. We like to explore and find out new things.

Caring ~ We like to help people. We care for plants and animals.

Reflective ~ We think about our work. We find ways to be better.

Communicator ~ We can express ourselves in many ways. We listen to others.

Knowledgeable ~ We know a lot of things. We can remember what we have learnt.

Risk-taker ~ We have confidence to try new things. We challenge ourselves.

Balanced ~ We take care of our minds, our bodies and our feelings. We take care of our needs.

Principled ~ We choose to do the right thing. We are honest.

Each unit of inquiry provides ample opportunities for our learners to develop and enhance these attributes through various meaningful engagements. Currently, in LKP, the focus is on being a reflective learner and a communicator as we learn to reflect on our actions and express ourselves in different ways. In Nursery, we are learning to be open-minded as we find out about our classmates' similarities and preferences. In Pre-Nursery and Under 2s Programme, we focus on being a risk-taker and inquirer as we take on new challenges and try a variety of activities.

How can you promote the Learner Profile Attributes at home?

- Think about the types of questions that you ask your child at home? Are they usually questions which require a yes or no answer? Try to ask open-ended questions and give your child adequate time to answer.
- When you are out and about with your child, encourage them to look around and observe what is happening.
- Give value to what your child has to say, try not to dismiss their answers or observations and encourage them to explore different ways of expressing their thoughts and feelings.
- Allow your child to reflect on what they are doing and encourage them to ask questions if they don't understand certain things.
- If you don't know the answer to a question that your child has asked you, take this opportunity to explore and find the answer together.
- Use positive words of encouragement to promote their learning and independence, especially if they are trying something new for the first time.
