

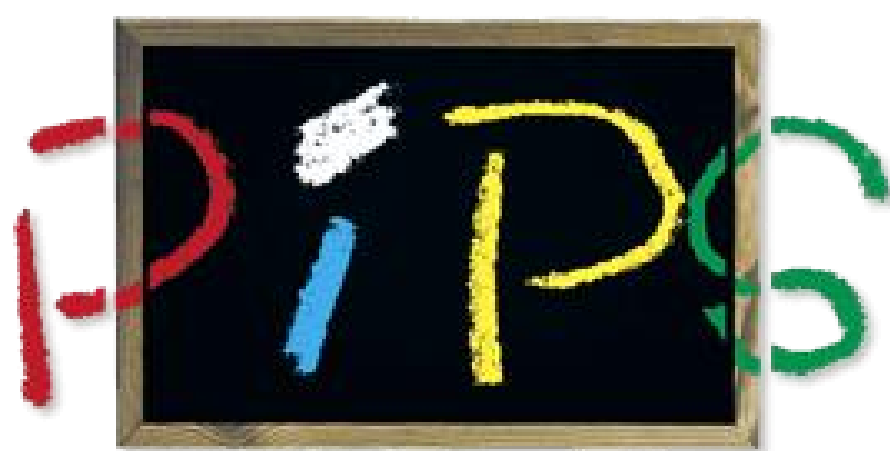

# Extra-Curricular Activities Policy 2022/2023

Please note our ECA policy is only applicable to in-house ECAs, Ballet, Performing Star Junior and Speech & Performance.

## **Enrollment 報名方法**

## **Refund / Withdrawal 退款/退學**

No refund will be provided for students withdrawing after the first class commences. Students who have successfully enrolled in a course and withdraw before the course commences will be charged 20% of the course fee.

若天文台發出紅雨、黑雨或三號以上颱風警告時，當天各項課程將會被取消，並不設補堂。

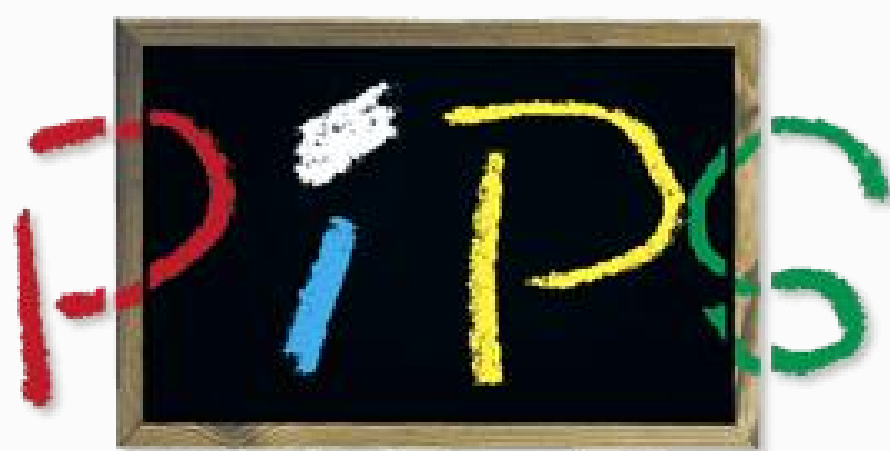

## Playgroup friendly reminders

- Each student is to be accompanied by **\*\*\*ONE ADULT\*\*\*** and **ONLY THIS ADULT** can remain on the school premises. The accompanying adult's role is to assist, interact, and participate with the child in the class.
- The **SAME ADULT** is to accompany the student for the **ENTIRE SESSION**.
- The accompanying adult must comply with the Playgroup teacher's instructions as well as pay full attention in caring and engaging the student at all times. You are responsible for the child's safety.
- Please bring a **NUT-FREE** snack and beverage to each session. Please be reminded that PIPS is a **NUT-FREE** school and nut allergies may lead to severe medical complications.
- Students and the accompanying adults are required to **REMOVE THEIR SHOES** before entering the classroom. For hygiene reasons, please wear socks or indoor shoes.
- Students who are not well will be asked to stay at home to minimise the risk of infecting others.
- Mobile phones must be **TURNED OFF** during the entire lesson.

The younger group may focus on speaking skills, such as pronunciation and building vocabulary, while the older group may practice guided reading and journal writing.

## Fun with Phonics & Pinyin (Saturday)

We would like to offer children the opportunity to join our Fun with Phonics and Pinyin class. The primary aim is to expose children to the wonderful world of letters, characters and sounds, developing children's communication skills. Through small group learning, children will enhance their letter and character recognition, read phonetically in English, and use Pinyin when reading Chinese. Their confidence to express themselves will improve through a wide range of reading and writing engagements in English and Chinese.

This course will be catered for the 4 - 6 age range within a two-hour timeframe.

STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Maths) activities are all about inspiring our next generation of inventors and innovators. Through these activities children can have huge amounts of fun by creating like an artist, designing like a technologist and building like an engineer, enhancing their critical and scientific thinking skills.

Activities such as pendulum paintings, ribbon rockets, toy car markers, glow stick paintings, shadow artwork, the egg drop and more will motivate and expand the children's knowledge of STEAM. Children will record their findings on iPads and record their discoveries to their parents through Seesaw. There will also be a Putonghua Enhancement element during this course where basic character skills will be promoted.

Class A specifically tailored for 2.5 to 4 year olds which introduce the alphabet of movement through creative expression and prove to be an excellent foundation for students wanting to pursue the study of classical ballet. Skills are learned in their most basic form to initiate the process of building a solid foundation helpful in the future dance study. Taking the special characters of these age levels into consideration, their wonderful imagination and boundless energy, many of the exercises and skills are taught through story, song, and role-playing. Concentration is one establishing developmental skills needed to execute dance steps. Exercises enhance flexibility. Coordination, strength, and muscle tone. Introduction and experimentation of movement with various styles of musicality, rhythm and creativity.

The aim of Class B, 4 to 6 year olds, is to produce a proper understanding and execution of basic ballet technique. Emphasis is placed on the discipline and classroom etiquette required of all ballet students. Class work begins at the ballet barre. Students are guided through a series of exercises designed to strengthen the leg muscles and train the torso and upper body in order to maintain proper ballet placement. Simple conditioning exercises are begun to ensure suppleness in the muscles necessary in the years to come. Center combinations are kept simple and appropriate. Center work incorporates technique, coordination, awareness of space, and sensitivity to music – all vital to the understanding of classical ballet.
