#### **International Mindedness**

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PIPS is a registered IB World School and both of our campuses are certified to teach the IB Primary Years Programme (PYP). The diagram below shows how the PYP is organised to achieve International Mindedness across our curriculum.

Throughout our programme, we aim to develop the whole child under the 6 transdisciplinary themes of Who We Are, How We Express Ourselves, How the World Works, How We Organise Ourselves, Sharing the Planet, and Where We Are in Place and Time. We incorporate the six learning areas of child development which includes Science, Language, PSPE, The Arts, Mathematics and Social Studies, within our units of inquiry across the year. Providing ample opportunities for our children to develop the attributes of the Learner Profile, which is in the heart of our teaching and learning.

With the international backgrounds of our families, we celebrate the diversity of the languages that we all speak by offering Bilingual and Trilingual language immersion classes across our teaching levels of Pre-Nursery, Nursery and Lower/Upper Kindergarten classes to achieve International-mindedness.

During the course of the school year, we incorporate many international festivals and celebrations into our curriculum such as Diwali where we invite our students' families to come into school to share and take part in some of their cultural activities, Dragon Boat Festival where parents demonstrate how to make traditional dumplings to our students, Easter Bonnet Parade, Chinese New Year Flower Market and Christmas celebration and at the end of the school year there is an International Day to celebrate all cultural diversities of our teaching staff, students and families.

## Summer Camp 2021

Summer School 2021 is now open for applications. It will run for three weeks from the 12th to the 30th July 2021. It will be a wonderful time for your child to learn about all about summer, including weather, food, clothing and activities. They will have the opportunity to engage in science activities, art projects, cooking and role play while enjoying lots of songs and games.
